**Criteria for admission as a Professional Member of the ITIA  
– Translator –**

1) A postgraduate qualification in translation awarded by an Irish third-level institution or similar foreign institution recognised by the Irish Translators' and Interpreters' Association

***Plus***

A minimum of 2 years full-time (minimum of 200,000 words/year) work as a translator (or a correspondingly longer period part-time)

***Plus***

A PASS in the ITIA Professional Membership Examination

**OR**

2) A primary degree in translation awarded by an Irish third-level institution or similar foreign institution recognised by the Irish Translators' and Interpreters' Association

***Plus***

A minimum of 3 years full-time (minimum of 200,000 words/year) work as a translator (or a correspondingly longer period part-time)

***Plus***

A PASS in the ITIA Professional Membership Examination

**OR**

3) A minimum of 5 years full-time translation work (minimum of 200,000 words/year), where the PMSC is satisfied that there may be sufficient grounds for exemption

***Plus***

A PASS in the ITIA Professional Membership Examination
